

Suggested Guidelines for the Policy Committee of the W.S.C.

The guidelines of the policy committee help the Fellowship as a whole to protect the Traditions.

We do not make policies for N.A. but help the Fellowship in keeping within our Traditions.

NOTE: THE TRADITIONS ARE THE POLICY OF N.A. AS A WHOLE.

The guidelines are as follows:

1. The Policy Committee will discuss policies in question, brought to this committee during the committee sessions.
2. The Policy committee will then draft a brief report on the policy(s) in question, (including all important points, pro-con).
3. The report will later be presented to the Conference for review and the recommendations of the Policy committee.
4. The Policy committee will have at least two (2) meetings per year. One in Sept. and the second at least 3 months prior to the Conference.
5. The Chairman will be responsible for corresponding with the rest of the sub-committee members.
6. These guidelines can be changed or added to any time by the Conference of a 2/3 majority vote of the Conference.
